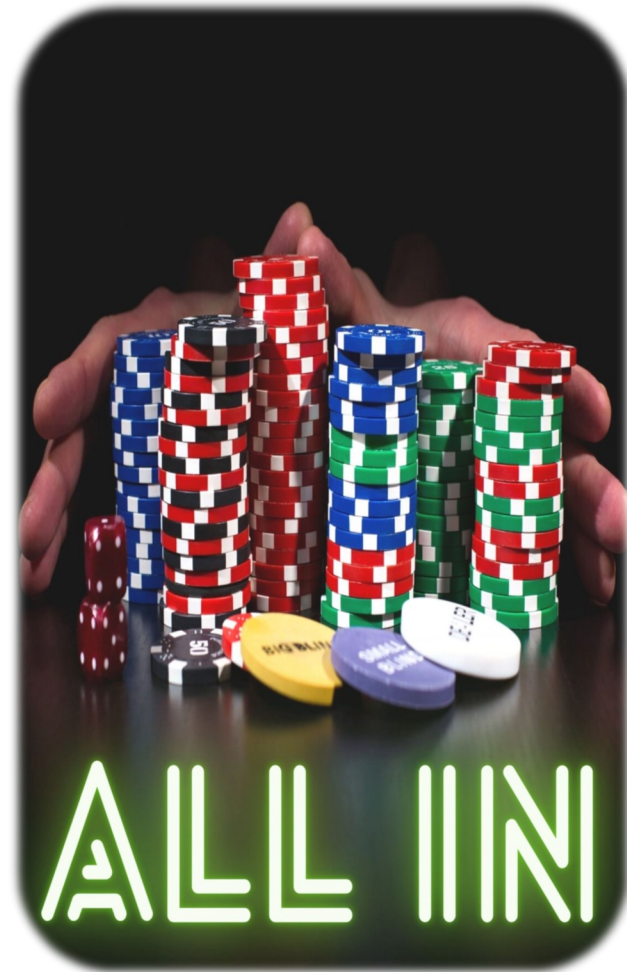


Registration for the 2021-2022 school year begins on March 15 for the general public.
